General Info about San Judas Chico

- 41 girls ages 6-16
- Home has been in operation for 50+ years
- The **orphanage** offers safe refuge for girls coming from impoverished families or even worse: violent homes where they were physically or even sexually abused. Some girls were just abandoned while their parents left in search of a better future for themselves, others parents have passed on already.



Projects: Classroom/Study Hall



- Tile the floor
- Add ceiling and fix lighting
- Fill in holes between roof and walls
- Add cubbies for the children's backpacks and books



Other Projects

- 2 solar panels to heat water for bathroom showers
- Expand the laundry drying area with additional roofing



Educational and Vocational Projects

- Scholarships
 - School fees, school supplies, backpacks, shoes, and outfit = \$100 per student
- Sewing Training
 - Instructor salary for 6 months = \$1500
 - Sewing supplies = up to \$1000
